There are currently two Parish Council vacancies and the Parish Council is inviting applications from residents who are passionate about helping to shape the future of our local area.

As a Parish Councillor, you will:

Help make decisions on matters affecting the parish.

Work with fellow councillors to improve local services and facilities.

Play an active role in supporting and enhancing our community.

No previous experience is necessary - training and support will be provided. All that is needed is an interest in your community, a willingness to listen, and a commitment to making a positive contribution. To be eligible, you must:

Be at least 18 years of age.

Be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or another qualifying country.

Meet the legal qualifications for serving as a parish councillor.

The Parish Council meets regularly throughout the year, every six weeks on a Monday night in the village hall, and Councillors are expected to attend meetings and participate in council business.
