A tribute to the very special lady 'Daisy Sadler' of Lower Tadmarton

In this issue we say goodbye to one of the most well known characters to have lived amongst us.

Daisy Sadler, well known to so many people, sadly passed away on Friday 3rd of October. Daisy, formerly known as Sue Halkyard, was born in Bowness-on-Windermere in 1944. She married Josh Sadler and the couple shared a passion for amateur classic car racing. They moved to Tadmarton in 1997.





Daisy ran Sydney's Exploditions, providing a carriage service for special occasions. Many a friend and neighbour had the pleasure of hiring Daisy and her heavy horses. My first sight of them carrying a full wagon load of hearty, well fuelled gentlemen back from the Hooky Beer Festival to the Stags Head. And, I'm sure each of them behaved impeccably with Daisy at the helm!

Daisy was a very thoughtful carer for those that needed it in the community as well as a tireless supporter of charities. In 2018, she drove her waggon on a 1,000-mile journey to The Kelpies near Edinburgh. The five-month trip not only

raised £27,000 for the Brain Tumour Charity but saw Daisy win Horse and Hound magazine's 'Inspiration of the Year' award in 2018.

Nick Bailey, a close friend, said: "Whether it was driving her 1929 Austin 7, Chumley Carruthers – a wedding present from Josh in 1973 – or her magnificent gypsy wagon, Daisy was both a very popular and prominent member of the Oxfordshire community. Such an incredible, kind and loving lady who stoically continued fighting her illness until the end."

From those who knew her and indeed those of us who just knew of her, she will be deeply missed.
