Editor's bit

Hoorah! May has arrived! And so have my favourite migrants bringing the promise of a wonderful summer!

Every year I look expectantly to the skies from the beginning of April to witness the return of the Swifts and Swallows to our beautiful Neighbourhoods and this year I spotted the first of these wonderful birds on April 2nd! Nice and early, which in my book is definitely the sign of a glorious few months ahead!

The educational bit: Both species are long distance migrants: Swallows will fly around 7,000 miles whilst Swifts can fly over 124,000 miles in a year as they only perch when nesting. They literally do everything else in flight - eat, sleep (yes! sleep), even mating on the wing! Who knew?

Swifts typically arrive from Africa late April and head home in early August, whilst Swallows arrive April and off they pop again to Africa late Sept/Oct. And with their typical life spans, every year sees actual returning visitors.

From the packed skies over Swalcliffe & Tadmarton to an absolutely packed issue of The Link this time round!

Lots of news from both of our villages, including 'Hold the Dates' as far out as October, results from events held earlier in the year and some requests from your local Councils and Charities that you may want to support. If you are new to either villages, volunteering to support is a great way of getting to know people and having fun!

Whatever the late spring brings you, I hope along with the sunshine I feel is going to stick with us, happiness and health is included!

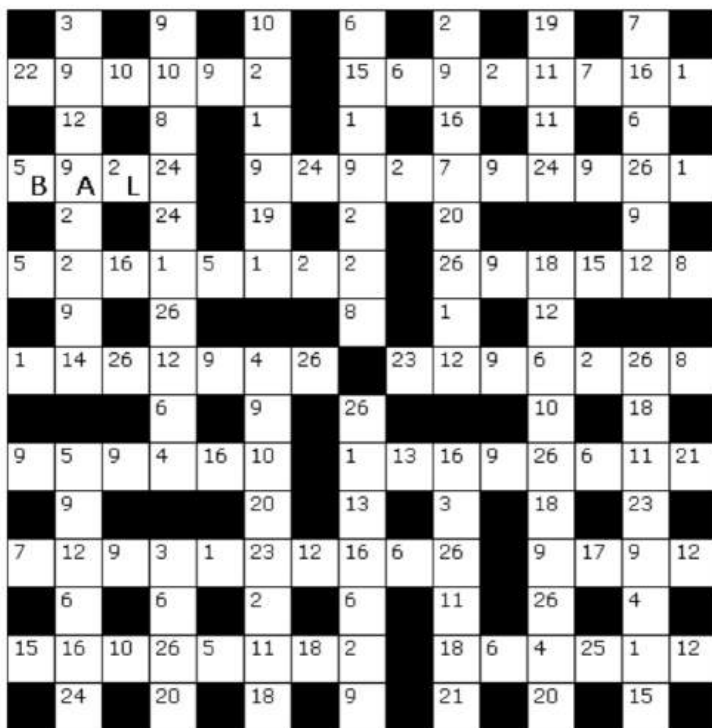

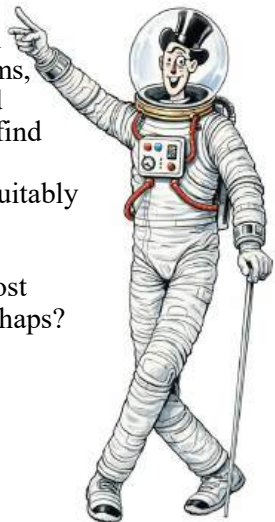

We will of course keep all the information we have already gathered, ready to resurrect should interest return."

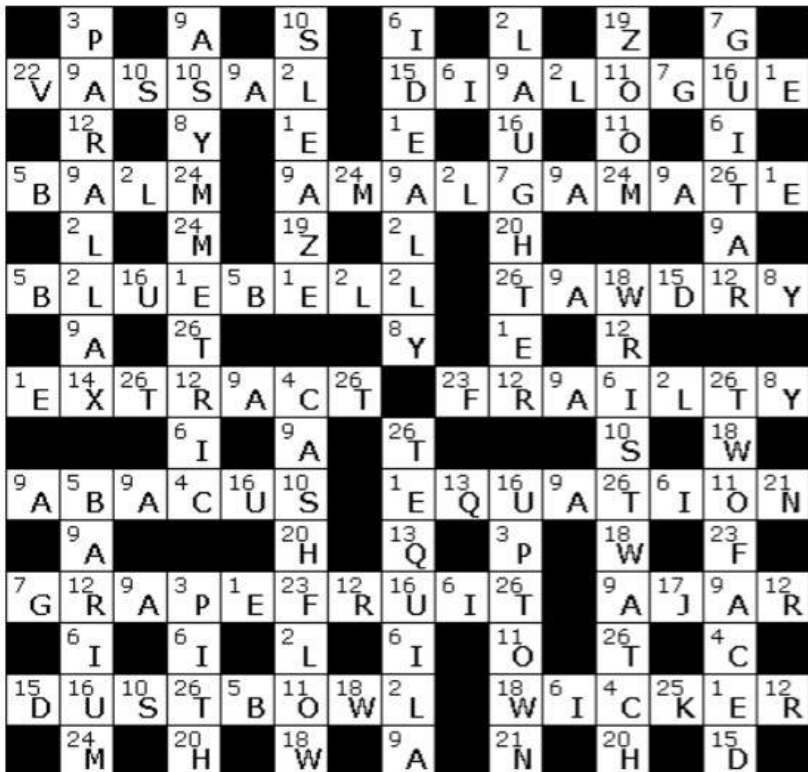
